Monthly Need: \$21,654

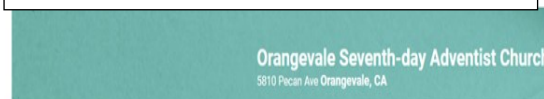
Family Life Center Fund or School Mortgage:

The school building is called the Family Life Center. The building cost over \$3M. Construction was completed in April 2004 but the building is not paid for yet.

Orangevale Church is responsible for a mortgage payment \$6,485 every month (estimated payoff in Nov 2030)

Loan amount still to pay: **\$465k**
