Monthly Need: \$21,654

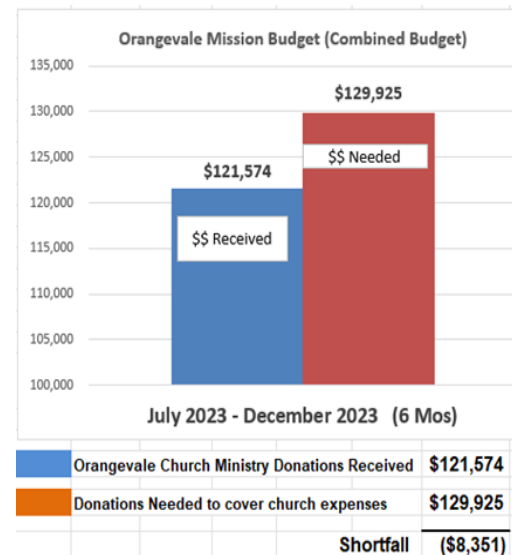
Family Life Center Fund or School Mortgage:

The school building is called the Family Life Center. The building cost over \$3M. Construction was completed in April 2004 but the building is not paid for yet.

Orangevale Church is responsible for a mortgage payment \$6,485 every month (estimated payoff in May 2030)

Loan amount still to pay: **\$437k**

(From the Sabbath School Lesson, January 18th, 2024)

“The Lord’s supremacy in the world as the Sovereign Creator, King, and Judge has theological implications for reliability of His testimonies. The testimonies refer to the body of laws and ordinances with which the Lord governs the religious and social life of His people. They are “very sure”, reflecting the stability and permanence of God’s throne and the world that God created and sustains. The Hebrew word as “sure” (the English word *amen* derives from this word) conveys the notion of reliability, faithfulness, and firmness. God’s laws are unchangeable and indestructible”.
