PASTORAL SEARCH PROCESS & PROCEDURE

The Northern California Conference (NCC) is responsible for hiring within our conference. The conference Executive Committee meets four times a year, and delegates pastoral search and hiring to The Pastoral Placement Committee (PPC).

The PPC meets every month, and is made up of pastors, various office representatives (such as an ethnic coordinator, MV, youth coordinator, specified areas of ministry, and administration) and laypeople

2

Each church has a designated representative from the PPC.

- ◆ That representative's primary job is to meet with us, get to know as much as possible about our church and school community.
- ◆ He finds out the most important characteristics we feel we need in a pastor, along with any names we may want to refer for this position.
- ◆ He takes all the information gathered back to the Pastoral Placement Committee, and they begin their search.

Once a pastoral candidate has been identified as a potential fit, their name and resume is referred to the elders and church board to determine whether we'd like to proceed with an interview. In the interview stage, there are two questions that we are looking to answer:

- ◆ Do they fit the characteristics that we, as a church have identified?
- ◆ Is this someone we think we can work with, and they can work with us?
